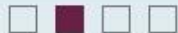

- The test is non-invasive.
- Requires a doctor's prescription.
- Covered by Medicare.
- Test kit is mailed to you.
 - You leave a stool sample in test kit container.
 - Mail it back.
 - They test for blood in stool and traces of cancerous DNA.
 - Claim 92% success rate in detecting cancer.
 - They recommend the test for people 50 and older unless you have a history of colon cancer or have irritable bowel syndrome, ulcerative colitis or other intestinal problems that put blood into your stool.

TSA Precheck

Why should you get one?

- 2-3 hour long lines at major airports (Austin is not that bad!)
- If you can't stand that long or can't go that long without using the bathroom

The Process ~ Make an Appointment

- Apply online or in person
- Show ID
- Get fingerprinted
- Pay an \$85 fee
- An FBI investigation will take another few weeks.
- Receive a Known Traveler Number (KTN).
- See your airline on how to use the KTN to get "TSA Pre" printed on your boarding pass.
